
WHAT'S INCLUDED

HERE AT THE SHACK WE BELIEVE IN GLAMPING.. SO THE FOLLOWING WILL BE PROVIDED FOR YOUR COMFORT

- Basic supplies
 - Salt, pepper, vinegar, cooking oil
 - Glad wrap, aluminum foil, baking paper and paper towel
 - Washing up, cleaning supplies and garbage bags
 - Tea towels, oven mitts, heat mats
 - Basic first aid supplies - no medicines
- Appliances
 - Fridge/freezer
 - Microwave
 - Electric frying pan
 - Dishwasher (powder included)
 - Oven with gas cooktop
 - Kettle
 - Toaster
 - Washing machine (powder included)
- Kitchenware
 - Cutlery, bowls and plates
 - Coffee mugs, drinking glasses, wine glasses
 - Salad bowls and servers
 - Serving platter, cheese knives
 - General cooking utensils, sharp knives
 - Mixing bowls, cutting boards
 - Potato peeler, grater, can opener

The Shack is a self-catered accommodation. This means that you will need to bring certain items to make your stay more enjoyable.

Your reservation includes:

- Access to the property for a maximum of 15 guests at any given time (any increase on this must first be approved by the owners)
- Access to camping and (depending on your reservation) a number, or all of, our bedrooms, which includes 3 rooms with a queen bed in each, and one room with 2 singles. This is a bunk house, like seen in mining camps. It is by no means grand (actually probably 1 star) but it will provide you with a comfortable bed, air-con and shelter from the rain! Basically it saves you pitching a tent.
- Access to the toilet block, which includes a shower (with hot water) and separate toilet (BYO toiletries)
- Access to the shack and all its amenities
- Use of large drinks esky (Ice is available at the Kairi shop and Pub)

Some other things to bring along...

- Yabbie pots and bait
- Towels
- Linen - this is provided by us only for bookings that include the bunkhouse

THE ESSENTIALS

Being a self-catered experience, there are a few items you'll need to bring along.

You can make your stay as simplistic or as grand as you like.

Linen

We do not provide linen, so if you have booked the bunk house, please remember to bring

- Sheets (3 x queen & 2 x king singles)
- Pillow cases
- Towels
- Blankets

Food

Although we will provide the basic cooking necessities, you will need to bring your own food for breakfasts, lunches, dinners and snacks (unless you're dining out at the spectacular cafes and restaurants nearby!)

Water and drinks

The water to the Shack is filtered bore water. It has been tested as potable and we drink it all the time! If you'd prefer bottled water, please feel free to bring your own.

Recommended clothing and shoes

We recommend bringing sunscreen and clothes, togs and a hat that provide high sun protection, as you will most likely be spending a majority of time outdoors or in the water.

Please also bring some shoes that will be suitable for all of the terrain such as mud, broken shells and sand.
